


Mindset

Principle 1: Prep for not being prepped

- Hashags: DIY, adhoc, improvise
- Rely on practise, not on tools
- “the back of the napkin”

Prep for not being prepped

- Sketch on lap
- dismiss grid and other templates
- I love brush pens but this is not art class
- Any random pen and paper must do
- Goal: **feel save to get your point across with any pen and paper** 😊

Principle 2: “Move **slow
and make things”**

Principle 2: “Move **slow** and make things”

- step back
- breathe
- thinking and design take time
- “feel free to go grab a coffee, I need 5 minutes to figure something out” is a totally fine thing to say

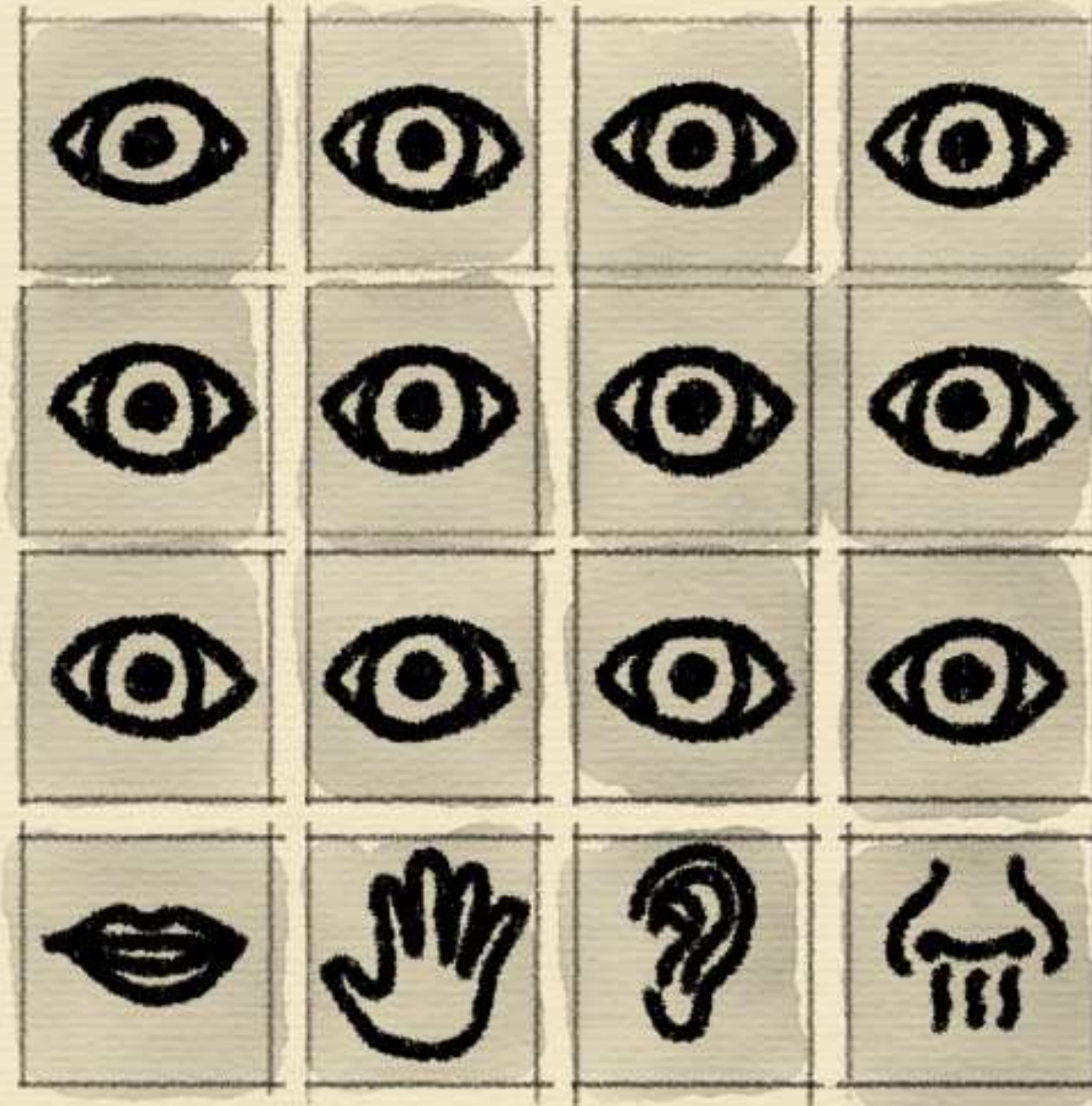

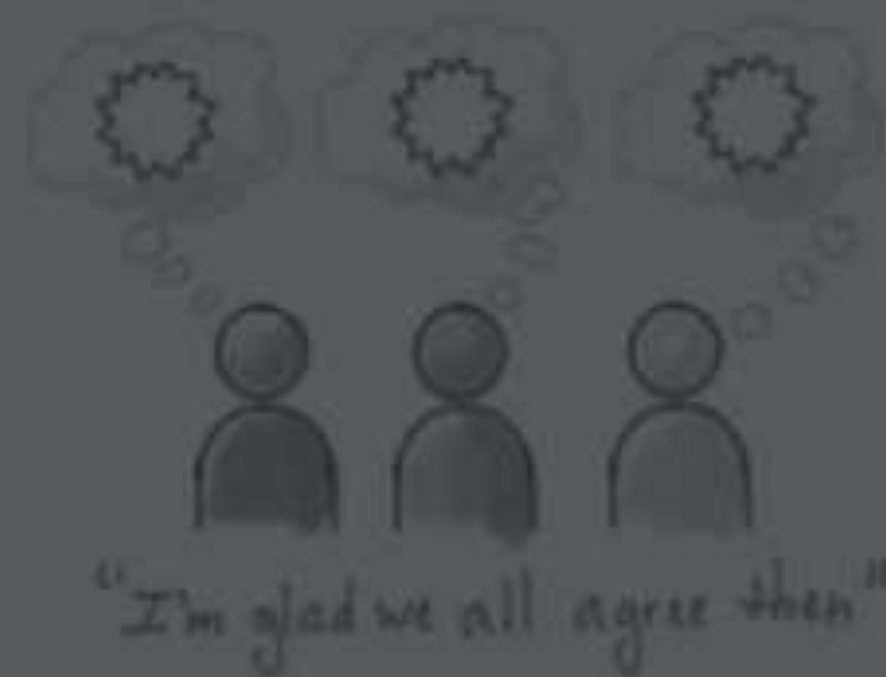

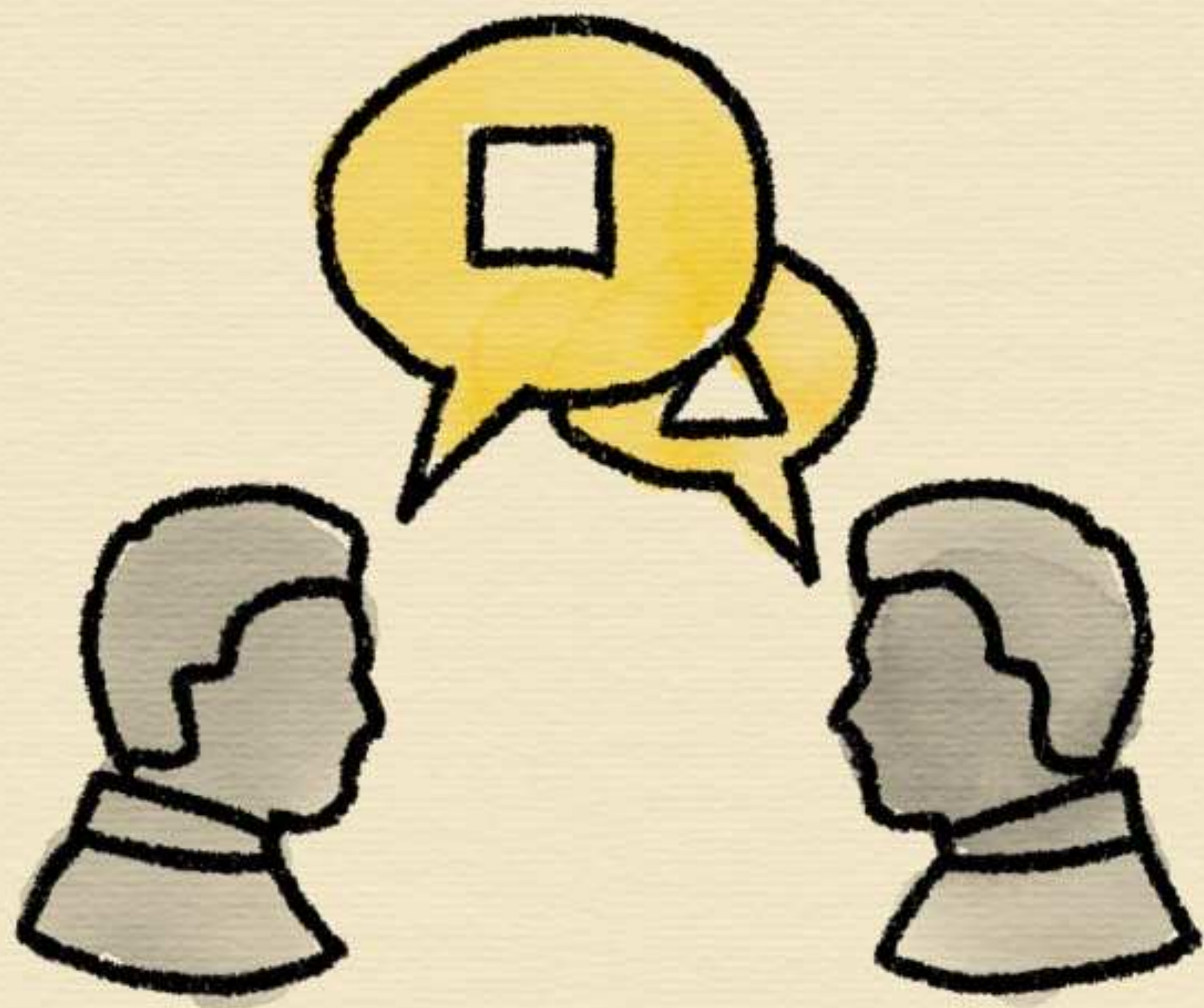

It's about having an informed **conversation**

Not about producing beautiful artefacts!



PRACTISE

Typography Writing

- Chose 3 objects or things you like
- Me: pen paper tea
- Write them down in normal handwriting

- Write them uppercase
- Write them larger
- Write slower

Remember: move slow and make things :)

- Dissect each letter into single strokes
- Pull pen from paper after each stroke
- Compare first to last

SHAPES

- triangles, squares, circles
- (dots and lines)

- make two random dots and make a line between the two
- don't fizzle – make one clear, slow stroke
- no worries, it will get better with practise :)
- Get as much stroke dynamics as the pen allows

- 1. make one Triangle, one Square, one Circle (they may overlap)
- 2. goto 10
- One stroke at a time
- Always close shapes. Overlapping corners are fine.
- Shake up your routines
- Try dotted, cloudy and robot lines

This is great practise, great warm-up and great meditation.



Highlighting

- Shadow
- Box
- Double lines
- Knock back w/ crosshatching

Arrows

- Point of arrow is on axis with line
- Purposefully curved is much easier than trying to get straight ones right
- Full-shape arrows are difficult and rarely worth it

Interface stuffs

- Text placeholders
- Image and icon placeholders
- Buttons
- Adhoc-guides and grids

Illustrations Stealing Icons

- open thenounproject.com on your phone (it's basically a great icon database)
- look up one of your three favourite things and chose an icon (simpler is better)
- copy the icon three times to paper
- **you have 5 minutes**

Putting it all together #1

- (leave some space at the top left)
- write that favourite thing in large, slow uppercase
- put your illustration to the top left
- make a box, leave out the illustration
- highlight the box
- repeat. repeat again.
- **you have 5 minutes**
- put 3rd version on the wall

Putting it all together #2

- Open your favourite app on your phone
- x-ray outlines
- dissect into the 5 vocables
- copy three views to paper
- close shapes and highlight interaction hotspots
- smart: 1 minute **just looking* and one minute sketching
- **you have 6 minutes**
- put **the last one** on the wall
